How CSAS software helped to convict an Ilford company director of multiple speeding offences



The role of CSAS

City of London Police used CSAS software to establish that Khan's mobile phone number was in the vicinity of the area, at the time of the offence, on three out of the five occasions.

The Result

Khan was found guilty of perverting the course of justice. He was jailed for eight months, disqualified from driving for 27 months and fined £2,000.

The Case

Tauqir Khan, 47, was caught breaking the speed limit several times in his customised Range Rover Vogue. Khan claimed someone else was driving and gave a false name to police.



The Trial

After a three-day trial at Inner London Crown Court, Judge Davies QC, described Khan's actions as 'striking right at the heart of the judicial process'.
